#### Important Restrictions and Rules

- Teams must be located within the jurisdiction of Central Valley Robotics (Mono, Madera, Fresno, Kings, Tulare, Inyo, and Kern counties) and participate at one of our Official Events.
- Robotics Kit (EV3 / WeDo) is loaned out and expected to be returned at the end of the season.
- Teams must have a solid plan for sustainability after their first year.
- We will prioritize submissions for Title 1 (or equivalent) schools and areas.
